Optimizing a Process Decide which processes should be optimized. Determine the process elements. This can be accomplished by asking the following questions: • What is the process goal? • When does it start and end? • What are the activities within the process? Who (employees and departments) is involved in the process? • What information carries between each step? Review the current methods of accomplishing the process. Ask the following questions: • Are there things being done manually that may be automated? • Where are the process redundancies? • How many employee hours does it take to complete this process? • How many employee hours could be saved with process cuts? • Where are the process bottlenecks? • Where do process errors occur? Remove non essential steps identified so far. Identify: • Which steps were cut? Determine which steps can be automated.
